More critical repairs may include flooring repairs, security improvements, minor plumbing and electrical work.

- *Homeowner Rehabilitation Assistance Program*
 - Assists low-income property owners in the rehabilitation of their homes. Eligible owners may receive a 0%, deferred loan in an amount not to exceed \$30,000 to cover major repair expenses to the structural, electrical, plumbing, and mechanical systems of their homes.
- *Homeowner Replacement Assistance Program*
 - Assists low-income property owners in the demolition and replacement of their dilapidated homes. Eligible owners may receive construction financing which may include a combination of a deferred loan and 0%-interest loan based upon the cost of the work and the owners' ability to repay.
- *Minor Repair Program*
 - Assistance program designed to alleviate immediate threats to the health and safety of low-income homeowners by providing grants up to \$5,000 for minor home repairs.
 - Improvements may not bring the entire structure into the compliance with codes.
